



- Ensure continued State funding by demonstrating demand


- Simple & streamlined application process

- No upfront commitments or fees





## **AIP Project Guidelines**

#### • Eligible projects:


- NEW stores using natural refrigerants (CO2, Propane, Ammonia)
- EXISTING store equipment replacement or system remodel using natural refrigerants

(Example: Replace case lineup with R290 or CO2 self-contained cases)

Supermarket/food retail applications

#### Application Considerations:

- New construction planned for next 2-3 years? 5-10 years?
- Aging equipment that needs to be replaced in 1-2 years? 5-10 years?
